## God's Divine Plan

Matthew 28:19-20

Intro:

- An illegitimate baby girl is left at an orphanage unwanted lonely scorned. But, then, a family adopts her. She becomes one of the family - socially acceptable - the object of love. She loses all her right to her old family but becomes heir to her new father's estate. She acquires a new name & a new character. In essence, she becomes a new person!
- 2. Gal 4:7 So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir.
- 3. You are adopted by God. You lose your rights to the old life but become heir to everything your Heavenly Father has. Your life changes. You acquire a new name. You become a different person!
- 4. Surely everyone wants this & God wishes that none would perish but have eternal life Jn 3:16.
- 5. So why isn't everyone a Christian?
  - a. Because some will not accept the Lord no matter what you do or say.
  - b. Because some know about Jesus but have never been introduced to Him.
  - c. Because they have never been shown the way, the truth & the life! Jn 14:6.
- 6. You have the responsibility to share the gospel with those around you. But how?
- 7. Here is God's Divine Plan!

## I. Step 1: Begin Seeking the Lost!

- A. This was our Lord's mission. Lk 19:10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost.
  - 1. The angel appeared to Joseph & said, She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins. Matt 1:21.
  - 2. According to Matt 15:24, Jesus went to the lost sheep of Israel first & then said, I have other sheep that are not of this sheep pen. <u>I must bring them also</u>. Jn 10:16.
  - 3. The Lord will not be satisfied until everyone has had a chance to receive eternal life!
    - 4. ILL: The One Lost Sheep (Lk 15:3-7).
- B. This is still our Lord's mission as He lives His post resurrection life in you!
  - 1. He told you to Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation. Mk 16:15. He wants to continue the job in & through you.
  - 2. In II Cor 5:20, He calls you His ambassadors!
  - 3. Notice His strategy in Rom 10:14 How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear <u>without</u> <u>someone preaching to them</u>?
  - 4. No one can come to the Lord until he has first been taught! We have quite a responsibility, don't we?

## II. Step 2: Continue Seeking the Lost!

- A. Finding is the reason for seeking, right?
  - 1. To stop seeking without finding is to fall short of your responsibility. But how many of you, if you seek at all, quit without finding?
  - 2. How many of you ignore the opportunities you have?
    - a. Who in your own family have you really talked to about God?
    - b. Does your next door neighbor go to church anywhere? Do you even know?
    - c. How about the people you work with throughout the week?
  - 3. If you are prayerful, diligent & persistent, you will find!
  - 4. With The One Lost Sheep; the shepherd looked for that lost lamb until He found it!

- B. The reward for finding is joy. (Lk 15:1-32)
  - 1. The Parable of the Lost Lamb.
    - a. v5 And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders.
    - b. v7 I tell you that in the same way there will be more <u>rejoicing in heaven</u> over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.
  - 2. The Parable of the Lost Coin.
    - a. v9 And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin.
    - b. v10 In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.
  - 3. The Parable of the Lost Son. v24 For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' So they began to celebrate.
  - 4. Remember this, says Jam 5:20, whoever turns a sinner from the error of his way will save him from death and cover over a multitude of sins.
  - 5. There is no joy like watching someone you've witnessed to commit their life to the Lord!

Make this your evening prayer: "Lord, use me to witness to someone this week. With Your power, help me to introduce them to You"!
