Don't Miss the Real Meaning of Christmas

John 1:1-13

Intro:

- 1. ILL: "While the World Sleeps".
- 2. What are things which if left out would lessen the real meaning of Christmas?

I. v1-5 - The Word Made Known in the Cradle

A. v1-2 - What was the Word?

- 1. Word $(\lambda \delta \gamma \circ \varsigma)$ = the verbal expression of a thought.
 - a. We get our word "logical" from this word.
 - b. Related words in the original language are translated "speak", "defend in court", "give an account", "reason" & "question".
- 2. When God created He spoke & things happened!
 - a. The Word was expressed & the heavens came into being the land appeared the oceans gathered vegetation grew rivers flowed winds blew fish swam animals roamed birds flew flowers bloomed.
 - b. The Word, then, was what created everything that exists.
- B. v14 Then this Word became flesh!
 - 1. What did He provide?
 - a. v4a Life abundant & eternal.
 - b. v4b Light guidance, direction & purpose for that life!
 - c. ILL: The darkness at New Cave at Carlsbad.
 - 2. v5 But like Adam of old who rebelled against God by eating the forbidden fruit some of you would rather ignore the light grope around in the darkness & do things your own way by using the Trial & Error Method!
 - 3. So unless you see the cradle overshadowing the commercial you'll miss out on the real meaning of Christmas!

II. v6-8 - The Witness Made Known in the Cross

- A. John's witness was in his message.
 - 1. v29 Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!
 - 2. Remember the real Christmas tree is the tree on which Lord Jesus hung & died!
 - a. Act 5:30 The God of our fathers raised Jesus from the dead whom you had killed by hanging him <u>on a tree</u>.
 - b. Act 10:39 We are witnesses of everything he did in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They killed him by hanging him <u>on a tree</u>.
- B. John's witness was in his baptism.
 - 1. It witnesses 2 things:
 - a. It portrays the gospel message of our Lord's death, burial & resurrection. I Cor 15:1-4 Now, brothers, I want to remind you of <u>the gospel</u> I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand . . . For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ <u>died for our sins</u> according to the Scriptures, that <u>he was buried</u>, that <u>he was raised</u> on the third day. . .
 - b. It portrays what's happening in your heart your death to your old life the burial of the old corpse & the resurrection of your life into a brand new life! Rom 6:1-5 Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore <u>buried with him</u> through baptism <u>into death</u> in order that, just as <u>Christ was raised from the dead</u> through the glory of the Father, <u>we too may live a new life</u>. If we have been united with him like this in his death, we will certainly also be united with him in his resurrection.

- 2. It is within this response (to the cross) of baptism that you can ceremonially come in contact with the blood of Christ.
- 3. So unless you see the cross overshadowing the cradle you'll miss out on the real meaning of Christmas!

III. v9-13 - The Welcome Made Known in Conversion

A. Since God chose to invade human history in the way He did - everyone of us are forced to make a choice.

- 1. Here is the choice:
 - a. <u>Surrender</u> to the Lord's authority over you.
 - b. <u>Do nothing</u>!
- 2. v12-13 If you decide to make a commitment to the Lord you will find direction to an otherwise purposeless life light in the darkness!
- 3. v9-11 If you decide to do nothing you automatically choose to remain in darkness with it's results lack of direction & eventual eternal death!
- B. v13 <u>Birth</u> means total conversion.
 - 1. You are to become a new creature. Il Cor 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, <u>he is a new creation;</u> the old has gone, the new has come!
 - 2. Becoming a new creature means forsaking your old lifestyle. Rom 6:6 For we know that <u>our old self</u> <u>was crucified with him</u> so that the body of sin might be done away with, <u>that we should no longer</u> <u>be slaves to sin</u>.
- C. v12 <u>Faith</u> implies total commitment.
 - 1. Faith is more than just believing stuff.
 - a. The demons believe the facts & they shudder! (Jam 2:19)
 - b. ILL: The Demon Possessed Man (Matt 8:28-32)
 - 2. Faith involves:
 - a. The total surrender of your life to the control & direction of God.
 - b. Trusting God to work out everything in your life to your good & His glory (Rom 8:28).
 - 3. So unless you see conversion to the Lord overshadowing the cross you will miss out on the real meaning of Christmas!

ILL: A Rescuer Rejected! God left heaven to become a man. That man died on a cross so you could have eternal life with Him. When you turn your back on Him how do you think He feels? Surrender your life to this loving God & you'll experience the real meaning of Christmas!
