Why God Sometimes Doesn't Seem to Answer Prayer

Intro:

- 1. God's promise is that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. Rom 8:28.
- 2. But Robin is dying of cancer!
- 3. Why did Dana have to die?
- 3. Why, when you pray for things, do they go wrong anyhow?

Acts 1:1-8

I. Sometimes You Don't See the Big Picture

A. ILL: Amy's Kitten.

- 1. Kittens are safe in trees.
- 2. But Amy doesn't see things the way adults see them.
- B. God sees everything in context whereas we tend to only observe the immediate.
 - 1. Esther was queen of Persia at just the right time to save her people (Esth 4:14).
 - 2. ILL: Time is like a terrarium.
 - 3. Ps 90:4 For a thousand years in your sight are like a day that has just gone by, or like a watch in the night.
 - 4. Il Pet 3:8-9 But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day. The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.
 - II. Sometimes the Problem Would Become Worse If Answered
- A. We see things distorted God sees them as they really are. ILL: Dan's kitten's silhouette in the evening sun.
 - 1. Rom 11:33 Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How
 - unsearchable his judgments, and his paths beyond tracing out!
 - 2. I Cor 1:18 For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.
 - **3.** I Cor 1:25 For the foolishness of God is wiser than man's wisdom, and the weakness of God is stronger than man's strength.
 - 4. I Cor 3:19 For the wisdom of this world is foolishness in God's sight. As it is written: "He catches the wise in their craftiness";
- B. Thankfully, there was a time when He didn't answer my earnest prayer! Example ILL: My application to Grace Theological Seminary.

III. Sometimes the Timing is Not Right

- A. God's timing is not our timing; it's better!
 - 1. Abraham questioned God's timing no son to inherit his property (Gen 15:2-5; Heb 6:15).
 - 2. The Lord hesitated 2 days before going to raise Lazarus (Jn 11:6)
- B. Promises to wait on the Lord.
 - 1. Ps 37:7 Be still before the LORD and wait patiently for him; do not fret when men succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes.
 - 2. Lam 3:25 The LORD is good to those whose hope is in him, to the one who seeks him.

Pray earnestly. Pray believing God will answer. But – always trust the Lord for His best for you!
