Why Should You Not be Ashamed of the Gospel

Intro:

- 1. Why do you suppose so few of us witness like we should?
 - a. Is it because you feel you would be stereotyped as a religious fanatic?
 - b. Is it because you are afraid that your witness wouldn't be received it might be rejected?
- 2. You feel like standing up with Peter & proclaiming, Even if all fall away, I will not ... ! (Mk 14:29)
- 3. Yet, like Peter, you end up denying the Lord time & again.
- 4. Are you so ashamed of the Lord that you are reluctant to introduce Him to those you know?

5. In verse 16 & 17 there are 4 reasons why you don't have to be ashamed of the gospel!

I. Because It is the Gospel of Righteousness - v17

- A. Gospel (τὸ εὐαγγέλιον) = the "Good News".
 - 1. ILL: Courier bringing the victory announcement to the king.
 - 2. Paul defines what the Christian gospel is.
 - a. I Cor 15:1-4 Now, brothers, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain. For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day.
 - b. So the gospel is the story of the death, burial & resurrection of the Lord!
 - c. Rom 5:21 says that eternal life comes <u>through</u> Jesus Christ because <u>only He is</u> the way & the truth & the life. No one comes to the Father except through Him Jn 14:6.
- B. Righteousness (δικαιοσύνη) = justification, to be considered not guilty, to cause to be in a right relationship.
 - 1. In ancient times, the gods were impersonal & had to be appeased to win their favor.
 - 2. Justification was determined by how good you lived. When you goofed, you made a sacrifice to be put back in good standing.
 - 3. Righteousness doesn't mean to find reasons to prove you are good.
 - 4. Righteousness doesn't mean God makes you a good person.
 - 5. Righteousness, here, means God treats you as though you were never a sinner!
 - 6. Because of what Lord Jesus did on the cross, you have the opportunity to be considered by God as His child - you can have a loving father-child relationship.

II. Because It's the Power of God - v16

- A. Have you ever dreamed that you had the miraculous gift the apostles had to perform miracles?
 - 1. ILL: Michael's attempt to raise the dead.
 - 2. God has chosen not to perform these supernatural events routinely today like He did in the first century.
- B. Power ($\delta \dot{\nu} \alpha \mu \iota \varsigma$) = is where we get our word "dynamite". It's a mighty, unconquerable force.
 - 1. The gospel has the power, in & of itself, to persuade, to convict & to convert.
 - 2. If you dare to proclaim His gospel to your lost & dying family, friends & acquaintances you will reap the joy of using the power of God!

III. Because It's for Salvation - v16

- A. Salvation ($\sigma\omega\tau\eta\rho(\alpha)$ = deliverance from danger, to be rescued.
- B. What are you saved from? The NT uses this word these ways.
 - 1. You are saved from <u>danger</u>. ILL: Jesus stills the storm. (Matt 8:23-27).
 - 2. You are saved from this wicked world. Acts 2:40 Save yourselves from this corrupt generation.
 - 3. You are saved from <u>being lost</u>. The Lord said, For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost. Lk 19:10.
 - 4. You are saved from <u>sin</u>. The angel came to Joseph & said, She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because <u>he will save his people from their sins</u>. Matt 1:21.
 - 5. You are saved from the wrath of God.
 - a. There is wrath for those who choose to remain separated from God.
 - b. II Thess 1:7-8 the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels. He will punish those who <u>do not know God</u> and <u>do not obey the gospel</u> of our Lord Jesus.

IV. Because It's for Everyone Who has Faith - v16-17

- A. It's for everyone! Salvation is available to everyone regardless of race, background, appearance or citizenship.
- B. Who has faith. What's faith?
 - 1. In II Thess 1:4 it means loyalty.
 - 2. In I Cor 15:17 it is <u>a conviction</u> that something is true.
 - 3. In II Cor 13:5 it is the Christian way.
 - 4. In II Cor 5:7 it is an indestructible hope.
 - 5. It's an <u>absolute trust</u> You can bet your life that there is a God who cares for you like a Father cares for his child!
- C. Faith progressing in believers in stages or degrees.
 - 1. Receptivity "I'm willing to listen."
 - 2. Mental Assent "What you say is true."
 - 3. Total Surrender I have been bought with a price & am no longer my own I Cor 6:19-20.

If you've been a bit cowardly with your witness lately, remember that you're cheating yourself of using the power of God. People will respond to the wonderful message of the death, burial & resurrection of our Lord!
