## I'll Just Take My Chances

Romans 7:14-25

## Intro:

- 1. Death is simply a transition into another life.
- 2. The Bible says you will live forever either in heaven or in hell.
- 3. Nearly everyone wants to go to heaven, of course, but are not sure how to make that happen.
- 4. The Bible points out to us 2 possible ways & divides our Bibles into 2 sections, the Old Testament & the New Testament, to point out those ways.

## I. The Old Testament Way

- A. How most people think about getting to heaven.
  - 1. People are divided into two categories: good guys & bad guys.
  - 2. Good guys go to heaven, bad guys go to hell.
  - 3. Since God is a God of love most people will probably get in.
- B. What's the standard that determines which category you fit? Where's the line where when you step over it you're a bad guy?
  - 1. Well, it's kind of a relative thing basically if you're not a criminal & treat other people reasonably well, you're a good guy.
  - 2. Hell is reserved for the real sick 'os who mow people down in high schools & burn down homes & chase folks out of their country.
  - 3. But who set those standards? Your parents? The government? Who says those are the standards?
  - 4. The truth is you decide if you're a good guy or not & most of us have determined that we're in the good guy category.
- C. The first possible way of getting to heaven considers this type of thinking it gives us some very absolute standards The Law of Moses!
  - 1. ILL: Moses getting the Law.
  - 2. The Law is what God determined to be <u>the standard!</u> Obey the commandments & go to heaven; don't obey & go to hell.
  - 3. The 1st half of the 7th Chapter points out what this Law could & could not do.
    - a. v7-8 The good news is it points out what the standards are.
    - b. v9-11 The bad news is once you fail to obey one command you've blown it there's no provision in the Law for forgiveness!
    - c. Jam 2:10 For whoever keeps the whole law & yet stumbles at just one point is guilty of breaking all of it!
- D. SO according to the Bible, if you choose to try to get to heaven simply by being a good guy you aren't going to make it!
  - 1. Perfection is the minimum standard for entrance into heaven. You've got to know the Law of Moses & then obey it to perfection all of your life & never goof.
  - 2. Only Lord Jesus ever lived a perfect life.
  - 3. If anyone else lived a good guy life it would have been the Apostle Paul & he's the one who wrote this biblical book!
    - a. Rom 3:10 There is no one righteous, not even one.
    - b. Rom 3:23 All have sinned & fall short of the glory of God.
    - c. Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin is death.

## II. The New Testament Way

- A. Jn 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His one & Only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.
  - 1. You & I are filthy rotten sinners no matter how much of a good guy we try to be.
  - 2. God sent Jesus on a mission to help us out of this sin problem.
- B. This is the way He did it!
  - 1. He paid a price He didn't have to pay. Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin is death.
  - 2. Jesus lived a perfect, sin free, life. He didn't have to pay that wage.
  - 3. But He volunteered to pay it anyway. He took your place on the cross!
  - 4. The cross fills in the gap between your life & God's standard for getting into heaven. (Rom 4:5)
- C. How do I respond to this?
  - 1. Surrender your life to the Lordship of Jesus let Him call the shots in your life.
  - 2. Trust Him to save you & give you a place in heaven forever.
  - 2. Spend the rest of your life loving Him & expressing your appreciation to Him by living for Him.

The OT way: obey the rules perfectly & I will be your God & you will be My people.
They flunked!

The NT way: Lord Jesus paid your debt for you so you could go to heaven forever. So identify with Him. Trust Him. Appreciate Him.

You win!
