## The Cure for Inferiority Complexes

Intro:

- 1. What is an inferiority complex? Everything is against me. Everything in my life is going wrong. I can't do anything right. I always make wrong choices.
  - a. Life does get tough. Things do go wrong.
  - b. You're in a hurry & all the signals are red.
  - c. You're about to go on vacation & you're summoned for jury duty.
  - d. You lose your job about the time your car breaks down & your wife leaves you.
- 2. Your career comes to an end.
  - a. ILL: SFC at Ft. Rucker who committed suicide.
  - b. ILL: My active duty career ending at Ft. Ord.
- 3. When life makes you think you're in the gutter you need to remember who you were created to be!

Ephesians 1:3-14

I. v3-6 - God, the Father's, Plan for You

- A. **v3** God intends for you to be blessed.
  - 1. Blessed (εὐλογέω) = worthy to be spoken well of.
  - 2. God intends for you to be a spiritual blessing to others on earth.
  - 3. God wants you, as a redeemed person, to be the showcase of God's intention for mankind.
  - 4. You are the pinnacle of God's creation & He brags on you! ILL: God bragging about Job (Job 1 & 2).
- B. v4 God intends for you to be holy & blameless.
  - 1. Holy  $(\check{\alpha}\gamma\iota o\varsigma)$  = separate different from ordinary things set apart for a divine purpose.
    - a. This word described an object dedicated to the Greek gods. So these objects were different from the ordinary.
    - b. You are not to be like the world but different from the world in the ways you behave.
    - c. You are not to be politically correct to fit in but to be godly enough to make a spiritual influence on the people around you.
  - 2. Blameless ( $\ddot{\alpha}\mu\omega\mu\sigma\varsigma$ ) = without any blemishes.
    - a. To the Jews, before an animal could be used as a sacrifice on the altar, it had to be inspected by the priests.
    - b. It had to be perfect. If it had any blemishes it would be disqualified to be an offering to God.
    - c. Rom 12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to <u>offer your bodies as</u> <u>living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God</u> — this is your spiritual act of worship.
  - 3. How has God made this possible for you?
    - a. v7 He provided for your past by forgiving your sins.
    - b. v13-14 He provides for your present by indwelling you with His Holy Spirit.
    - c. He will provide for your future by glorifying you. Col 3:4 When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.
- C. v5 God intends for you to live as adopted children.
  - 1. ILL: Roman Adoption.
    - a. The adopted person was considered a new person beginning a new life & was not responsible for past debts.
    - b. He was the property of his new father!
  - 2. I Pet 2:9 But you are <u>a chosen people</u>, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, <u>a people belonging to God</u>, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.
- D. **v6** God intends for you to live as ones who have received grace.
  - 1. Grace is unmerited favor. Lord Jesus provided that grace to you when He died on the cross!
  - 2. ILL: Mary Fitzpatrick. (Amy Carter's private nurse in the White House was a convicted murderer!)

## II. v7-14 - God, the Son's, Provision for You

- A. v7 Lord Jesus provides for you redemption.
  - 1. Redemption ( $\dot{\alpha}$ πολύτρωσις) = release affected by the paying of a ransom.
  - 2. The idea a slave is purchased from the slave block.
  - 3. Jesus paid the ransom for you when He died on the cross.
- B. v8-10 Lord Jesus provides for you an abundant life.
  - 1. Having wisdom & understanding the mystery of His will this is abundant life.
  - 2. v9 Made known (γνωρίζω) = (related to γινώσκω), knowledge gained by personal experience. The abundant life is something he wants you to personally experience!
  - 3. v10 Lord Jesus has everything in control. There is no such thing as luck for the Christian!
    - a. Epicurus: "God regards nothing but leaves all things to chance". <u>This is false</u>!
    - b. What the world calls luck the believer calls God's grace!
- C. v11-12 Lord Jesus provides for you an inheritance.
  - 1. I Pet 1:4 tells us the inheritance is kept in heaven & will not perish, spoil or fade.
  - 2. Col 3:24 says it is a reward for surrendering to the Lord.
  - 3. The ones who are predestined to receive this inheritance are those of us who "hope in Christ" those of you who have chosen Jesus as your Lord.
- D. v13-14 Lord Jesus provided for you His seal.
  - 1. v13 Who are the sealed? Those who heard the gospel, the word of truth, & believe.
  - 2. v13-14 What is the seal? God's down payment, the indwelling of His Holy Spirit you received when you are baptized (Act 2:38).

So - what do you remember when you get down on yourself & think you're worthless?
