3. "Dad was an elder in the church & mom sang in the choir. So, I guess, I'm alright."

4. "I was baptized as an infant & have been raised in the church ever since." (Genesis 17:12)

C. Paul had the right A______ - v5-6.

1. "But I'm one of the most active members of my church!" (Acts 21:40)

- "But mom sat us on her knee & taught us the Bible every night & I won a perfect attendance pin in Sunday School!" (Acts 5:34; 22:3 & Matthew 7:26)

- 4. "But I'm a good moral person; certainly not as bad as some of those hypocrites in the church!"

- E. Paul's first priority in life needs to be your first priority! v10-11.
