Your Faith Can Give You Confidence

Intro:

- 1. Confidence ($\pi\alpha\rho\rho\eta\sigma(\alpha)$ = unreserved speech, not afraid to speak your convictions, boldness.
- 2. Faith must not be based upon how you feel.
 - a. Emotions are so unpredictable & unstable.
 - b. Faith comes from something far more stable than emotions. Rom 10:17 <u>Faith comes from hearing</u> <u>the message</u>, and the message is heard through <u>the word of Christ</u>.
 - c. Emotions come as a result of faith!
- 3. How does having confidence help your life?
 - a. ILL: The Net Under the Golden Gate Bridge. (Jan 1933)
 - b. 25% more work was done each day when the men knew they were safe.
- 4. So if your faith, based on the word, gives you confidence; what are the things you can be confident about?

I John 5:12-20

- I. v12-13 & 20 You Can Be Confident That You Have Eternal Life
- A. v12 If you have the Son of God you can have confidence.
 - 1. Have you ever heard, "You can't really know if you have eternal life until you die"?
 - 2. ILL: The Man with the Bag of Potatoes. When I rest on the word of God, the weight gets less!
 - 3. The Lord said, Whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life Jn 5:24.
 - 4. "In Christ" you already have eternal life so trust it!
- B. v13 If you trust in His name you can have confidence.
 - 1. What are the elements of faith?
 - a. Trusting that Jesus is God's Son.
 - b. Trusting that what the Bible says is true.
 - 2. These elements are necessary to make your faith a saving faith, but they aren't what faith really is.
 - 3. Saving faith is trusting Lord Jesus to do for you what He promised to do for you.
- C. v20 If you trust that Jesus is God in the flesh you can have confidence.
 - 1. Lord Jesus is God in flesh! Jn 1:14 <u>The Word became flesh</u> and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, <u>the glory of the One and Only</u>, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.
 - 2. God made Himself fully known & understood in human terms through Lord Jesus.
 - 3. Jn 1:1 Lord Jesus was to the Father what a word is to the thought it expresses.
- II. v14-16 You Can Be Confident That Your Prayers will be Answered
- A. Prayers that will not be answered.
 - 1. You must have fellowship with God. Jn 15:7 <u>If you remain in me and my words remain in you</u>, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.
 - 2. You can make a selfish request & not be answered. Jam 4:3 When you ask, you do not receive, <u>because you ask with wrong motives</u>, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.
 - 3. A non believer has no assurance of answered prayer. Jn 9:31 We know that <u>God does not listen to</u> <u>sinners</u>. He listens to the godly man who does his will.

- B. Prayers that will be answered.
 - 1. v14 When you pray according to the Lord's will.
 - a. It doesn't mean tacking on the end of your prayer, "If it be your will". That's often a cop out for not praying for results!
 - b. It means knowing what God's will is through Bible study, prayer & associating with mature Christians.
 - c. The Lord's desire for you is usually greater than your desire for you! ILL: The Bigger Hand. & Choosing the Watch.
 - 2. v15 When you pray trusting the Lord for the results.
 - a. Mk 11:24 says to pray as though it has already been answered.
 - b. Matt 21:22 If you believe (trust), you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer.
- C. v16-17 An example of the prayer of a righteous person. Jam 5:16 The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.
 - 1. v16 Intercession for a sinning person can bring forgiveness if they have not committed the sin that does not lead to death.
 - 2. So what's a sin that leads to death?
 - a. Mk 3:29 says blasphemy against the Holy Spirit brings death. Why? That's a sin impossible to repent of.
 - b. I Cor 11:30 says lack of repentance at the Lord's Table can bring death.
 - c. Heb 6:4-6 says those who fall away from their faith have crucified Lord Jesus afresh & can't repent.
 - d. So the unforgivable sin is the sin that's not repented of!

III. v18-20 - You Can Be Confident That You Will No Longer be a Slave to Sin

- A. You are slaves to the master you obey sin & death or obedience & righteousness. Rom 6:16 Don't you know that when you offer yourselves to someone to obey him as slaves, you are slaves to the one whom you obey — whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness?
 - 1. Without Lord Jesus in your life, you are a slave to sin.
 - 2. But Jesus paid the ransom for your sin so you can be free to serve Him!
- B. v18 Born again children of God have been freed from the sin oriented life. Not having anything to do with that lifestyle will keep Satan from being able to get a hold of you again.
 - 1. Jam 4:7 says when you resist the devil he will flee from you.
 - 2. So how do you resist Satan? The same way Jesus did with the word of God (Matt 4:1-11).
 - 3. Then confess sin you have committed (I Jn 1:9).
 - 4. Then ask the Lord to fill you with His Holy Spirit (Lk 11:13) in that area of your life!
 - 5. You can then plan on living your Christian life victoriously!

What are the things your faith should give you confidence in? Eternal life - answered prayer & not remaining a slave to the sin oriented life!
